We will also gladly put you in contact with trucking companies if you are in the need of delivery.

TERMS: 50% deposit with order, balance due 2 weeks before pickup: **Bank Cashiers Check, or Bank Money Order. Cash will be accepted at pickup before truck is loaded.** Prices are based on present market conditions and are subject to change without notice.

\*\* There will be a **\$25.00** fee on returned checks for insufficient funds. Overdue accounts will be charged **1.5%** per month plus cost of collection if any.\*\*

CANCELLATIONS: Any cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to digging.

CONDITIONS OF SALE: Cancellations can not be accepted after stock has been dug. Trees must be picked up within a day or two after notification. Please bring tarpaulins or suitable coverings to protect the plants during transit. Even a short trip without proper covering will damage nursery stock.

LIABILITY: We exercise the greatest care in filling your order correctly, but if an error occurs it is mutually agreed that our liability is confined to replacement or refund not to exceed the original purchased price. We accept all orders subject to prior sales of stock and crop conditions. Orders shall be void should injury befall our stock from hail, fire, frost, error in count, or other causes beyond our control.

GUARANTEE:

We are not able to guarantee our dug trees, as we have no control over soil, weather, poor handling in transit, general care, planting, or maintenance conditions after the trees leave our farm. We will not replace trees that fail to live or thrive. However, the trees are dug with the size root ball (or larger) according to the caliber trunk of the species and the ANLA standards. While the trees are at our farm, they will be given the highest standards of care recommended by the industry.

TRANSPORT: All stock travels at the purchaser's risk and expense. Liability ceases when trees are picked up by the carrier. If breakage occurs or if stock suffers through delay in transit. Claims should be made immediately to the Transportation Company.

NOTE: It is the customer's responsibility to have ample equipment and manpower on hand at the time of delivery, ensuring an expeditious unloading time. Failure to do so can incur additional charges.

All B&B & Cut Trees must be counted and inspected upon delivery. Any discrepancies must be resolved before the driver leaves by calling our office for instructions. No adjustments will be accepted after the driver leaves.
